

BAYOU STATE REGIONAL HIGH POWER RIFLE CHAMPIONSHIP

16-18 April 2010

Donaldsonville, Louisiana

An NRA-Registered High Power Rifle Tournament

Finally! A Bayou State Regional Championship that that was not plagued with a high chance of rain! We had beautiful partly cloudy days for the team match on Friday, and the Regional match on Saturday. Windy conditions dominated the Bayou State Regional High Power Rifle Championships, proving the range's reputation for challenging shooting. The winds continued to support the range's nickname, "Perry on the Bayou." The EIC and Director's match on Sunday had light winds with a high overcast.



Sixty-three competitors fired on at least one day of the match, with eight 4-man teams shooting on Friday, 54 in the regional on Saturday, 34 non-distinguished shooters in the EIC match on Sunday, and 13 in the Director's Match. The regional match included competitors of all classes with 17 High Masters, 23 Masters, 10 Experts, 2 Sharpshooters and 2 Marksmen attending. These competitors hailed from seventeen states, including Arkansas, Arizona, Alabama, Florida, Georgia, Indiana, Illinois, Iowa, Louisiana, Nebraska, North Carolina, Ohio, Oregon, Pennsylvania, Texas, West Virginia, and Wisconsin, and again included members of the U.S. Army Marksmanship Unit (USAMU). Also, for the first time the All Guard Shooting Team brought a large team. As has become tradition, the post-match meal was held at the Palo Alto Plantation, which served another one of its excellent local meals for everyone involved in the match.



Eight 4-man teams competed in Friday's match. As with last year's 4-man team match, USAMU Craig took the top honors. The team was composed of Firing Members: **SPC Kevin Trickett**, **SSG Brandon Green**, **SGT Tyrel Cooper**, and **SFC Grant Singley** and Captain/Coach: **SSG Walter Craig** who fired a combined 1941-56X for top honors. All Guard Spiker (Firing Members: **SPC Cody Shields**, **SSG Allen Spiker**, **2LT Ryan Kuhn**, and **SPC John Beall**; Captain/Coach: **Allen Spiker**) turned in a nice 1940-56X for second place. USAMU Black (Firing Members: **SGT Calvin Roberts**, **SPC Augustus**

Dunfe, **SFC Lance Dement**, and **SSG Tobie Tomlinson**; Captain/Coach: **Don Heuman**) finished third with a 1923-55X.

The Match Director promised we would start on time, and we did. In fact, the first round downrange was at 7:58, two minutes before the scheduled starting time. The 2010 Bayou State Regional Champion was **SGT Tyrel Cooper**, who used his service rifle to fire a strong 788-35X. An impressive 196-8X at 600 yards ensured his status as the Regional Champion. The High Civilian for 2010 was **Dan Zelenka**, who fired a nice 774-15X, helped by an impressive showing in the rapid fire stages on a challenging, windy day. The Service Rifle Champion was **SFC Lance Dement**, who shot a close 787-30X. The Match Rifle Champion was **Danny MacGregor** (759-11X). This year's High Senior was **Dan Ramsey**, firing a 744-12X with a service rifle.

The CMP Excellence-in-Competition Match on Sunday found 34 non-distinguished shooters competing in overcast conditions with light, steady winds. **SSG Allen Spiker** won the match for the gold medal with a blistering 493-16X. The silver medal was awarded to **2LT Ryan Kuhn** with a 491-16X, and the bronze medal went to **MAJ JR Treharne** with a 484-15X. **SFC David Steinbach** was the top non-distinguished shooter receiving an 8-point leg with a fine 480-8X. The two 6-point legs went to **Warren Freeman** (his first leg points!) with a 470-11X and **SSG Brent Krumboltz** with a 469-16X. Finally, **Dan Karmolinski**, who won leg points at last year's Bayou State Regional, came up just short this year with a 469-7X, taking first leather. First Leather is a term that is used for the person who has the highest score short of having leg points awarded at an EIC match. It is generally an honorary title that leaves the recipient wondering how he could have scored just a few more points. At this year's match, however, **Doug Giraud** decided that the shooter ending up First Leather shouldn't go home empty handed and donated one of his renowned case trimmers as a consolation prize. Doug was not even able to make it to this year's match, but sent a trimmer anyway. **Thank you Doug!** Tell Doug thank you by going to <http://www.giraudtool.com/> and checking out all of his high quality high power shooting tools and equipment. This year we also fired a Director's Match so that all of the professional shooters would have something to do on Sunday! These shooters put on quite a clinic, turning in some really fantastic scores. **SGT Tyrel Cooper** extended his excellent week by winning the Director's Match with an outstanding 496-20X, followed closely by **SSG Brandon Green** who fired a 495-23X. Third place was won by **SPC Agustus Dunfey** with a 493-13X
