1<sup>st</sup> Annual Pearl Harbor Match  
Saturday, 18 December 2010

The cost of the match will be \$3.00 for members and Junior shooters, and \$5.00 for non-members. There will be no cash prizes. Scores will not be turned in to the NRA. Only WW II era rifles as used by the US are approved for entry in the Pearl Harbor Match. Approved rifles are: M1 Garand, M1941 Johnson, M1903 and 03-A3 Springfield, and M1917 Enfield. The rifle may be accurized. No foreign military rifles may be used. You must provide your ammo and you must be able to stay on target at 600 yards. This will be a 50-round match fired at 200, 300 and 600 yards using the National Match course with sighting shots.
