

Mid-Range Prone/F-Class Match on Saturday March 3, 2012

30 shooters made it to the line and considering conditions, some nice scores were turned in.

The Prone shooters fielded 8 shooters at the match. Rob Westfall, making his first match of the 2012 season, won the Prone side with a 594-18X. Rob also shot a perfect 200 on his 3rd string. Mark Altazin took 1<sup>st</sup> place Master with a 591-18X. Mark just missed a perfect 3<sup>rd</sup> string by 1 point. Good shooting, Mark! 1<sup>st</sup> place Expert/Marksman class went to David Bay with a 584-22X.

The F-Open class had 9 shooters on the line. Alton Britt took the win in the F-Class Open with a 590-28X. Alton missed a perfect 200 on his 1<sup>st</sup> string by 1 point. William Wittman, who was right on Alton's heels, took the honors for 1<sup>st</sup> High Master with a nice 589-26X. Jim Suber again won in the Master class, taking the win with a 585-16X. The Expert class was won by Gerald Boudreaux posting a nice 584-14X. Gerald posted a personal best 199-5X on his 1<sup>st</sup> string.

F-T/R had 13 shooters on the line and the match winner was Travis Williams shooting a Master score of 579-16X. Great job, Travis. Master/Master Unclassified was won by Matt Barnes shooting a 569-13X. The Expert class was won by Ray Nallie with a 576-11X. Craig Martin took 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Sharpshooter group and Rocky Bezet took the win in the Marksman class with a 550-7X.

Thanks to all for coming out and special thanks again to those folks who came out early and helped get targets up.

All in all, some really good shooting for the conditions.

Don't forget that the Spring Regional will be coming up May 5 and 6. Pre-registration information will be mailed out soon and early registration is encouraged.
