Tony Angellete was right on his heels for third with an 1157-48X. Bobby McKee also won the money match and \$20.00 with a perfect target, which included 5 hits {including the sighter}, on that 1" candy @ 100 yards.

On the prone side, yours truly led the way with an 1196-69X, Alden Marrero was second with an 1165-35X. Rick Mol was third with an 1151-23X.

For next months money match, we will do things a little bit different. We will have 1st., 2nd., and 3rd. place cash awards, This is only fair, as that match is a real challenge and we had shooters that had multiple hits and were not awarded for their fine shooting.

If we continue to have the interest, by the time we reach the last match in October, the pot for the money match will be in excess of \$100.00. Also, if the interest is there, I plan on holding a two day championship match following the same format with a \$20.00 entry

fee. We will have a meal after the match on Saturday and have cash awards for 1st., 2nd. and 3rd. place, for both F-Class and Prone shooters, in addition to the money pot.
