Folks from Tennessee, Florida, Texas, Alabama, Mississippi and Louisiana were all in attendance for the match

Day 1-

Saturday started out warm and got warmer as the day progressed, but that didn't stop 59 shooters from making it to the firing line. The Palo Alto winds finally began to make their appearance as the day progressed and shooters had to make adjustments for it.

Prone-

On the prone side, 11 shooters strapped into their jackets with Bill Jenkins and Charles Kemp battling back and forth all day for the lead, but at the end of Day 1, Bill was holding a 1 point lead over Charles, having shot a 597-28z to Charles' 596-32X. Gary Henry was only 3 points off the lead. Gary Henry, Rob Westfall and Bill Jenkins also shot perfect 200's on their 3rd strings.

F-Open-

There were 23 F-Open shooters with 12 High Masters battling it out. Lanny Russell, Don Geraci and William Wittman set the pace shooting perfect 200's on the first string. At the end of Day 1, Lanny Russell lead the group with a 597-32X. Last year's state champion, Alton Britt was close behind with a 595-32x.

F-TR

There were 25 in the FTR class. Last year's state champion, C.J. Britt jumped out to an early lead and never gave it up. At the end of Day 1 he sat in the lead with a 589-23X.

Day 2-

Sunday started out very different from Saturday. Temperatures were in the mid- to lower- 60's and overcast with 9 mile an hour winds.

Prone-

Day 2 started off where Day 1 ended with both Charles Kemp and Gary Henry shooting perfect 200's on their first strings, but at the end of the day Charles Kemp shooting an 1195-66X won the Prone State Championship title. Gary Henry took 2nd place with a 1190-55X.

1st in Class High Master went to Rob Westfall with a 1188-45x.

1st in Class Master/Master Unclassified went to Mark Altazin with a 1159-37X

1st in Class Expert/Marksman went to Robert Bose with a 1135-24X.

F-Open

These folks came out of the block quickly with several 200's and 199's fired on the 1st string. Competition was fierce between Lanny Russell and Alton Britt with the deciding factor coming down to the last string. Alton was able to hang on and bested Lanny by 1 point to take his second state championship in a row with a 1190-65X and Lanny took second with a 1189-62X.

1st in Class High Master went to Brian Bowling with a 1188-47X

2nd in Class High Master went to Eddie Trahan with a 1184-58X

1st in Class in the Master/Master Unclassified/Expert/Sharpshooter went to Barry Mize with a 1188-58X
2nd in Class in the Master/Master Unclassified/Expert/Sharpshooter went to Taylor Boudreaux with a 1166-41X. It should be noted that Taylor is one of our Junior shooters and at 16 years old she shot a perfect 200 on her first string Sunday morning! Great job, Taylor!

F-TR

C.J. Britt had some stiff competition the second day from Jade Delcambre but was able to hold on and like his dad take his second state championship in a row shooting an 1174-48X. Jade Delcambre took second with a 1169-43X.

1st in class High Master/Master/Master Unclassified went to Anthony Acrement with a 1163-33X

1st in Class Expert went to Marc Olivier with a 1164-33X

2nd in Class Expert went to Mickey Brinkman with a 1160-31X

1st in Class Sharpshooter went to John LeBlanc with a 1158-26X

1st in Class Marksman went to Chris Hebert with a 1115-14X
