

Cajun Classic 3200 Match Bulletin / Score Sheet

First of all, let me thank all of you who attended the match and made it such a great success. Also by the grace of GOD and the weather man, we had some of the best conditions for shooting that I can ever remember in the 10 years of existence of Palo Alto. Saturday we had a cloudless sky with temps ranging from the mid forties to the high seventies, with winds mainly out of the North East at about 10 - 15 mph. but were switching enough so that you had to keep a constant watch to keep up. Sunday was overcast with temps in the low fifties to the upper seventies. Winds were light and variable and almost calm for the majority of the match which resulted in some very high scores for the day. On average, the scores were 5 points or better than those fired on Saturday. At the conclusion of the day on Saturday, Yours truly was on top of the bench shooters with a 1595-154X followed by Don Geraci with a 1592-149X with Chuck Cazanave right on his tail with a 1591-150X. On the prone side, John McGowan led the field with a 1593-99X. Tommy Laing was second with a 1591-108X. Followed closely by Richard MCNeel with a 1589-80X. F-Class found Lance Whittemore on top with a 1593-143X, followed by his son Braden with a 1568-95X. Robert McCullough was third with a 1568-95X. Next up for the day on Saturday was the "Impossible Shot Challenge", which this year, proved to be impossible. Twenty -three shooters were not able to shoot thru the center of the lifesaver at 50 yds. However, Lance Whittemore did do it. However, it was on the sighter not on the one for record. Close, but no cigar. Prior to the challenge, all shooters were given a ticket to draw from the pot in case the shot was not made. The winner of the drawing for the pot { \$115.00 } was--drumroll please-- Don Geraci, who yelled so loud that he was probably heard in White Castle!!. When last seen Saturday, Don reminded me of the guy in the GEICO commercial riding down the highway plastered in dollar bills with them blowing all over the road. At the end of the day on Sunday when all scores were finalized, Yours truly was first in Bench with a 3194-313X. Chuck Cazanave was second with a 3188-297X. Don Geraci was third with a 3186-301X. On the Prone side, Tommy Laing was first with a 3188-232X. John McGowan was second with a 3188-210X. Richard MCNeel was third with a 3178-170X. F-Class was won by Lance Whittemore with a 3191-300X. His son Braden was second with a 3103-215X. Robert McCullough was third with a 3124-204X. All first place winners were awarded with \$100.00 gift certificates from Dan Killough-- Killough Shooting Sports. Second and third place winners were given cash awards.
