Current CMP Pistol rules will govern: *Competitors are responsible for being aware of the Match Program and all safety regulations contained in the CMP rulebook. Triggers may be weighed.*

Entries: Do not prepay for the match, entries and fees will be accepted day of the match.

Eligibility: Open to all eligible participants, no affiliation or membership required.

CMP Liability Release: A release must be on file with the CMP. If you need to complete a release form, you can find one at <http://thecmp.org/wp-content/uploads/affidavit.pdf>

Match Fees: EIC .22 Rimfire Pistol - \$20 EIC Service Pistol - \$20

Schedule of Events: Check-in is at 11:30 on the 50-yard range. Firing begins at 12pm or as soon as possible thereafter post EIC rifle match.

CMP Pistol Competition Rules: CMP competition rule 4.1.2 for .22 Rimfire pistol, and competition rule 4.1.1 for Service pistol requirements will be complied with by all competitors.

Course of Fire: Table 4 - 30 round Pistol National Match Course.

Ammunition Rule 4.4: Competitors in any CMP sponsored event may use any safe single-projectile ammunition appropriate for the pistol and cartridge that is being used.

Classifications: CMP classifications will be used.

Challenges: A \$2 Challenge Fee will be charged for lost challenges. Scores may only be challenged prior to awards.

AWARDS

- CMP EIC matches: Awards will be determined and awarded by the CMP pending the review of match results. Achievement Pins will be awarded based on CMP cutoff scores.
- Final Results: Results from the matches will be transmitted to competitors via listed email and posted on the CMP Competition Tracker web site's "Competition Results" list.

Highlighted Safety Notes – Competitors are responsible for adhering to **ALL** published CMP rules and Palo Alto range safety rules including as follows:

- The use of an empty chamber indicator (ECI) is required even while the firearm is in the case. Only during a preparation period or actual firing may the ECI be removed.
- Do not load and fire until instructed to do so by the range officer.
- Magazines may be inserted and EIC removed only during the preparation period or live firing.
- All brass must be policed.
- **CMP Rule 3.6.2 Eye and Hearing Protection:** All competitors and competition officials, including Scorers or Verifiers, are required to wear eye and hearing protection when on the firing line during CMP competitions. See rule book for further specifics on eye protection dimensions and proper wear.

¹ When this course of fire is fired with .22 Rimfire Pistols as a National Trophy or EIC Match, timed and rapid-fire series must start from the 45-degree angle ready position (Rule 5.1.1 b).						

9.3.8 EIC Minimum Credit Scores

To receive EIC credit points, the score fired by the competitor must fulfill the requirements of Rule 9.3.7 (*top 10%, etc.*) and equal or exceed the EIC Minimum Credit Score (MCS) for that discipline. Minimum Credit Scores are:

- a) Service Pistol: 250 x 300
- b) .22 Rimfire Pistol: 260 x 300
